

Anglophone + Admissions and entrance exams

Anglophone + admission:

- Students at the top of their Anglais Académique classes in collège
- Students having lived abroad or in a bilingual family and who have good oral and comprehension skills but lack training in reading and writing
- Motivated students having developed strong English skills through summer programs / international experiences and diligence
- Students working up to Etudes Anglophones by perfecting their skills

Anglophone + candidates must be capable of following the Education Nationale curriculum that prepares the French Baccalauréat in addition to having an excellent or bilingual-level of English.

Anglophone + Entrance Exams

Entrance Exams take place:

Mid-March for in-coming 6èmes

Entrance Exam

A two-hour exam including:

- 1. writing and reading skills
- 2. oral and listening skills,

to determine whether candidates have the necessary English skills to spend their English classes with Anglophone + teachers.

Students who successfully pass this exam are invited into **Anglophone** + classes. Students who demonstrate good English skills, but do not meet the level requirements of **Anglophone** + classes may be invited to attend Ecole des Langues.
